Keep pucks down on the boarded rinks to prevent injury to spectators and players. FREE for EVERYONE.
WESTVIEW RINK 1700 Block of 1st Street 10:00 am - 9:30 pm	Warm up shack and change room. Outdoor lights. Children under 10 years of age must be under direct supervision of a parent or guardian 16 years of age or older. Helmets are strongly recommended for all participants. Keep pucks down on the boarded rinks to prevent injury to spectators and players. FREE for EVERYONE.

Opening dates vary depending on the weather Typically it takes three to five centimeters of snow and an extended period of cold weather to make the rinks. Rinks will be closed if temperatures lead to melting and ponding.

FUN FOR EVERYONE

NOON HOCKEY
(Ages 16 and up.)

Full equipment is required. Noon Hockey is included in a Leisure Facility Pass. Please purchase online at www.estevan.ca or stop at the Information Desk. **Facility Daily Pass required.**

FAMILY SKATE
(adult or guardian is recommended)

An adult or guardian is required to be on the ice at all times with children. Helmets are recommended. Anyone on the ice must wear ice skates or ice cleats. Cleats are available at the Information Desk. Strollers are welcome on the ice but wheels must be clean.

SHINNY 6-10 YRS
(Ages 6-10)

Anyone on the ice must wear skates, helmet and gloves.

SHINNY 11-15 YRS
(Ages 11 - 15)

Anyone on the ice must wear skates, helmet and gloves.

SHINNY FAMILY
(adult or guardian must accompany)

Anyone on the ice must wear skates, helmet and gloves.

PRE SCHOOL PUCK TIME
(Ages 6 and under)

Anyone on the ice must wear skates, helmet and gloves.

PARENT & TOT SKATE
(adult or guardian must accompany)

No Hockey Sticks allowed during Parent & Tot Skate. Helmets are recommended. Anyone on the ice must wear ice skates or Ice Cleats. Cleats are available at the Information Desk. Strollers are welcome on the ice but wheels must be clean. **FREE ADMISSION. Sponsored by the Estevan Strippers Hockey Team.**
