

BYLAW #2022-2052

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF ESTEVAN TO AMEND SOLID WASTE BYLAW 2010-1814 BEING A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF ESTEVAN IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO REGULATE THE COLLECTION, REMOVAL AND DISPOSAL OF SOLID WASTES IN THE CITY OF ESTEVAN AND TO REGULATE THE USE OF THE CITY'S LANDFILL SITE.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Estevan, by virtue of *The Cities Act*, is authorized to pass a bylaw to regulate and operate a solid waste collection removal and disposal system and landfill site and pursuant to the provisions of *The Cities Act* and subject to *The Litter control Act, the Clean air Act and the Environmental Management and Protection Act*.

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Estevan deems it necessary and desirable to establish a bylaw to regulate and operate a solid waste collection, removal and disposal system including a landfill site and to operate this system as a Public Utility.

NOW THEREFORE Council of the City of Estevan in an open meeting hereby enacts as follows:

1. Amended changes to the following Section 8 shall be deleted in its entirety and the following substitution

Section 8. **RECEPTACLES – COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL**

- (1) *An approved enclosure for approved receptacles intended for permanent use where mechanical collection is practised, such as commercial and industrial applications, shall be constructed to meet the following criteria:*
 - a) *constructed on a base of concrete, asphalt or other surface of sufficient strength and durability as determined by the City Engineer.*
 - b) *have screening to meeting the following criteria:*
 - (i) *approved receptacles used where mechanical collection is practised for all residential developments which are located in residentially zoned districts, shall be concealed from sight from adjacent lots and streets by wood or metal fencing, or a masonry wall erected to a minimum height of 1.80 metres;*
 - (ii) *approved receptacles used where mechanical collection is practised for all developments abutting residential developments or sites zoned for residential uses, shall be concealed from sight from*

residential development/site, by wood or metal fencing, or a masonry wall erected to a minimum height of 1.80 metres;


- (iii) approved receptacles used where mechanical collection is practised for all developments located within or directly abutting downtown commercial sites, shall be concealed from adjacent lots and streets by wood or metal fencing, or a masonry wall erected to a minimum height of 1.80 metres; and*
- (iv) shall meet the following additional requirements:*
 - (A) minimum interior dimensions without roof: two decimal seven five (2.75 m) metres (length) x two decimal one (2.1 m) metres (width) x one decimal eight (1.8 m) metres (height)*
 - (B) if provided with gate, provide 2.75 meter clear opening provisions to fully open and 150 mm bottom clearance above base;*
 - (C) "NO PARKING" sign at entrance;*
 - (D) where direct collections vehicle approach is not available, provide sufficient clearance to permit container rotation of 40°;*
 - (E) have installed thereon a sign indicating the address of the premises served by the approved container located within the approved enclosure.*

Section 8 to be amended with the inclusion of :


*Section 8. **RECEPTACLES – COMMERCIAL/INDUSTRIAL***

- (1) Commercial receptacles shall be a commercial bin regulated for mechanical collection and shall generally be in good condition.*
- 2. This Bylaw shall take force and be in effect on the day of the final passing thereof.*
