Allergy-Friendly Treats: We kindly request that you prominently display allergy information for your treats, including common allergens like nuts, dairy, and gluten.

This thoughtful gesture will enable parents and caregivers of children with allergies to make informed and safe choices. This information will help us add a turquoise pumpkin to your designated area, indicating that your treats are safe for individuals with food allergies or other dietary conditions.

Sensory-Friendly Decorations: We kindly request that you do not decorate your area with strobe lights, fog machines, or loud sound effects. These elements can trigger seizures and migraines for individuals with epilepsy or sensitivities to lights.

Accessibility for All: Be prepared to describe the treats you are offering to children who are blind or have low vision. We will provide you with "yes" or "no" communication cards to facilitate interactions with children who may not give expected social feedback.

Clear Pathways: Ensure that there are clear, wide pathways leading to your booth, allowing easy access for children using mobility aids like wheelchairs or walkers.

Avoid any tripping hazards such as cords, uneven surfaces, or clutter.

No Pressure Approach: Be patient and understanding when interacting with children who may have communication difficulties or social challenges. Use a no-pressure approach and give them time to respond.
