

**BYLAW NO. 2005-1715**

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF ESTEVAN TO AMEND  
BYLAW 2005-1709 FOR LICENSING, PROHIBITING,  
REGULATING AND CONTROLLING OF ANIMALS.**

*WHEREAS*, Section 8 of *The Cities Act* authorizes a Council to license, regulate and control any animal or class of animals;

*AND WHEREAS*, it is deemed in public interest to regulate and control persons owning animals.

**NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ESTEVAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

**BYLAW 2005-1709 shall be amended by:**

1. Replacing the entire Section 11 with;  
“11. The owner of any dog or cat running at large is guilty of an offence.”
2. Replacing the entire Section 15 (a) with;  
“15 (a) The owner or keeper of a dog or cat that is on any school ground, playground or posted area except when the owner or keeper is attending a recognized training and obedience school for training of such dog or cat is guilty of an offence.”
3. Replacing the entire Section 16 with;  
“16. The owner or keeper of any dog or cat that chases any pedestrian, vehicle or any other animal on a public thoroughfare is guilty of an offence.”
4. Replacing the entire Section 19 with;  
“19. The owner or keeper of any dog or cat that causes damage to public or private property is guilty of an offence.”
5. Replacing the entire Section 32 with;  
“32. The owner or keeper of any dog or cat that is a nuisance by barking, howling or emitting other animal sounds continuously for a period exceeding ten (10) minutes is guilty of an offence.”

6. Replacing the entire Section 43 (a) with;  
“43 (a) The owner or keeper of pigeons, owned or under the person’s control that is outside the loft or flight pen except as follows is guilty of an offence:”
7. This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
